

By-Law VI: Discipline

- (1) The Society shall hold no disciplinary hearings of its own. All complaints received by the Officers against a member of the Society shall be submitted to the Students' Union's Disciplinary Committee.
- (2) The President, or in the event of his or her being a party in the complaint, an impartial Officer nominated by a Meeting of the Officers, shall assist the complainant.
- (3) At the conclusion of due process, the Students' Union's Disciplinary Committee may recommend the following penalties to the Officers:
 - (a) Issue of a formal written warning.
 - (b) Partial or total ban from certain Society activities.
 - (c) Disqualification from becoming an Officer.
 - (d) Removal of an Officer from office.
 - (e) Temporary or permanent revocation of membership.
- (4) A Meeting of the Officers shall confirm or reject, in whole, the penalty or penalties recommended by the Students' Union's Disciplinary Committee.
- (5) An anonymised report of all complaints submitted under this By-Law, together with any penalties imposed, shall be presented to each AGM.
