

By-Law XI: Amending the Constitution

- (1) A General Meeting of the Society may amend any provision contained in the Constitution provided that:
 - (a) Amendments do not:
 - (i) Alter the objects in such a way that undermines or works against the previous objects of the Society.
 - (ii) Retrospectively invalidate any prior act of a General Meeting or the Officers.
 - (b) Amendments are passed by at least a two-thirds majority.
- (2) By-Laws may be created, amended, and repealed in accordance with the Constitution by a simple majority.
- (3) The Students' Union shall be provided with an up-to-date copy of the Constitution and these By-Laws by the Secretary.
- (4) The Officers shall retain a copy of the Constitution and these By-Laws, which the Secretary must make available to members upon request.
