

By-Law I: Membership

- (1) A Meeting of the Officers or a General Meeting may admit persons to Full, Associate, and Honorary membership, in accordance with the Constitution and these By-Laws.
- (2) A Meeting of the Officers may set subscription fees for Full and Associate membership.
- (3) The Students' Union's Student Groups Officer and Vice President Democracy and Creative Industries are *ex officio* Full members.
- (4) The Officers must keep a register of names, University Student ID numbers, and contact details of the members, 'the register'. The Secretary must ensure that the Students' Union is provided with an up-to-date copy of the register at all times.
- (5) The Officers, or a General Meeting, may only refuse an application for membership if, acting reasonably and properly, they consider it to be in the best interests of the Society to refuse the application.
- (6) Membership shall be terminated if:
 - (a) The member resigns by written notice to the Officers.
 - (b) Any sum due from the member to the Society is not paid in full within six months of it falling due.
 - (c) A member ceases to be qualified for their category of membership.
 - (d) Membership is revoked in accordance with these By-Laws.
